HISTORY

The History strand offers learning opportunities and cultural experiences that link back to this collective identity as well as supporting learners in understanding the impact of the past on the future.



HERITAGE

Inspired by Nick Degg's poem 'I Come From A Town' in which he proclaims that people of Stoke are full of 'resilience, creativity and brilliance', the Heritage strand celebrates each of these concepts of what makes us unique both as a city and as a community.

By exploring Stoke-on-Trent's pottery heritage, learners will develop an understanding of what Stoke-on-Trent has to be proud of.




ENTERPRISE


NEXT STEPS

Our young people will take centre stage in the sustainability spotlight, as they use their voice to inspire others and champion initiatives that contribute to a healthier planet for our future.


Learners will have the opportunity to engage in projects on a local, national and international scale. Our competition winners in this strand will be going to Iceland!
